


iFerret 3.0 Update

The rollout of the new release is nearing completion for all customers (one to go) and the acceptance of v3.0 has been overwhelmingly positive.

iFerret users are reaping the benefits of a new user interface and a raft of new features including new connectors for the Microsoft suite of Sharepoint, One Drive and Teams. This means all documents kept within these Microsoft systems are now searchable from within iFerret.




As an added enhancement to version 3.0 we are now working on improvements to the Managed Result Set (MRS) functionality. This will include an inbuilt redaction function and make the whole process of creating and managing electronic packages much more streamlined and intuitive. The Benefits of iArchive

The IPLATINUM data archival solution, iArchive helps with the decommissioning of legacy systems (Finance, HRP, Property & Rating, Records, Assets and more) while allowing organisations to store historical data independent of application technology. This provides a mechanism to query and report on this data without the need for an application to support it.
